- Notify Me of All Volunteer Opportunities:** Find out about all opportunities at Highland!
- Book Fair:** Help children select books and pay for them, setup & teardown. Help needed during and after school hours.
- Classroom Helper:** Help with field trips, assist teacher with copying or projects, and any special events in your child's room.
- Contact Parent:** The PTA will plan both the fall and spring outdoor parties, your role is to come to the party and pitch in supervising students where needed. Also responsible for coordinating volunteers for your classroom booth at Spring Fling.
- Highland Spring Fling:** Highland's greatest tradition and main fundraiser will be held **April 13th**. Everyone is needed to help make this event a success! Committee meetings will begin in February. Volunteers are needed in all areas: planning, donations, decorating, games, tickets, setup, day of event and teardown. Help needed evenings for planning and Saturday, April 13.
- Family Engagement:** Help the committee chair plan events that encourage our Highland families to grow, learn and play together! For example, Reindeer Games, Movie Night, Heart of Highland Dance, etc. Help needed in evenings.

- Hospitality:** Provide food items for PTA sponsored events. Help plan luncheons and breakfast events.
- PASS Program:** Tutor students in areas they need attention to ensure success. Very rewarding opportunity and you can be placed with a student according to your scheduling needs.
- Popcorn:** Help pop, bag, and deliver popcorn on a rotating basis on Fridays. Volunteer regularly or as time permits.
- Talent Show:** Help plan the event, help with rehearsals, tickets, or other areas as needed. Help needed after school/evening.
