- MATH - Student will take an assessment on division (4.5, 4.6, and 4.7).
- Science - Students will study the Moon and its phases.
- READING - Test on viewpoint will be on Monday due to our Thursday Science Assembly. Next week we will continue with "A Refugee Remembers" Standards (5.RL.2.3) - We will discuss how to explain the relationships between characters and events in the story of John Bul Dau, a refugee in Africa. (5.RL.2.1) We will learn strategies to help us quote accurately from the text to explain what is happening in the story.
- Social Studies - (5.3.2) - We have been working very hard in our lapbooks to identify and describe the cultural and physical regions of the United States. Keep checking your student's agenda for upcoming quiz.
- Grammar - (5.W.6.1e) We will continue practicing writing with declarative, interrogative, imperative, and exclamatory sentences. Spelling test will include the identification of each of these types of sentences in their writing.
- Writing - (5.W.3.2)- This week we will review strategies to help write informative compositions on a variety of subjects. We will practice writing topic sentences, and learn how quotes can make writing more descriptive, detailed, and interesting. Students will research their favorite musician this week.
